Dance Teaching Artists at The Young Women's Leadership School of Staten Island Job Description

During the 2022 - 2023 school year, Arts Ignite will hold four (4) dance residencies at The Young Women's Leadership School of Staten Island. We are seeking one (1) Teaching Artist for each residency.

Throughout each residency, students will be offered the opportunity to engage in arts-rich learning led by their Arts Ignite Teaching Artists to explore multiple dance styles over the course of the school year. Teaching Artists are responsible for curriculum building, lesson planning for weekly classes, and working collaboratively with students and the Arts Ignite team throughout their residency.

Each residency will also focus on building students' positive peer relationships as well as the core skills of creativity, confidence, collaboration, and communication.

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About The Young Women's Leadership School

The Young Women's Leadership School, which currently has locations in four other boroughs and across the country, opened its first school in East Harlem in 1996 and has since grown into a national network of all-girls college prep schools. These schools are centered around four main principles: leadership, health and wellness, college access, and STEAM.

Arts Ignite Teaching Artists will be the primary classroom teachers for three (3) 45-minute in-person dance classes, held weekly on Thursdays during the 6th grade PE class period. Interested TAs should have experience teaching students between the ages of 11 through 14.

Job Requirements and Responsibilities

Arts Ignite Teaching Artist responsibilities:

- Curriculum building and lesson planning for three (3) 45-minute classes per week on Thursdays.
- Planning and teaching age-appropriate lessons that focus on the development of core skills.
- Regular collaboration and communication with Arts Ignite staff members for a cohesive program experience.
- Support and implementation of Arts Ignite methodology and pedagogical techniques in the classroom.
- Implementation of Arts Ignite evaluation tools in the classroom.
- Full participation in Arts Ignite training sessions.
- Full participation in Arts Ignite pre- and post-program surveys.
